



Troop 226 Aluminum Recycling Procedures



1. To start off with, try to get 10 of your closest neighbors to collect aluminum cans.
2. Use the handout letter to help explain the procedures to your neighbors.
3. Add neighbors to your list if you feel that you can handle the extra workload and storage of cans until the following Monday night Troop Meeting.
4. Collect, crush and seal your aluminum cans in plastic trash bags.
5. Bring your cans to the Troop Meeting and place them in the back of ASM Mr. McNeill's truck.
6. You can bring additional crushed, plastic bag sealed Aluminum cans to my house until Thursday night. Drive down the alley and place the bags between the truck and garage door – 5533 Buckskin Dr., 4-door, gray Ford Pick-up, camper and racks.

8. Square Deal Iron & Metal in Fort Worth will pay 60 cents a pound for aluminum. As of Feb. 9th, they are paying 70 cents per pound. It takes about 31 cans to make a pound of aluminum. If you know of a better deal, let me know.
9. The 2007 weekend collection dates for your neighbor's aluminum are:
