

## What to Bring to Camp

### Scout Uniform

- Official Shirt
- Official Shorts/Long Pants
- Scout Belt
- Scout Socks
- Scout Hat (if part of troop uniform)

### Camp Uniform

(daily wear for 7 days)

- Camp T-Shirts
- Handkerchiefs
- Socks (3-5 pair)
- Sweater or jacket
- Swim trunks
- Raincoat or poncho
- Underwear
- Hiking shoes and tennis shoes
- Bath towel and soap with dish
- Shower shoes
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Comb or brush
- Drinking cup
- Water bottle/canteen
- Sleeping bag or 3 blankets and pillow
- Cot or sleeping pad
- Flashlight (extra batteries)
- Bible or prayer book
- Boy Scout Handbook
- Notebook paper and pencil or pen
- Jeans (long pants)
- Insect repellent (NOT AEROSOL)
- Hat or cap
- Sun screen
- Long sleeve shirt (for swimming merit badge)
- COMPLETED MEDICAL FORM

### Optional Equipment

- Musical instrument
- Sewing kit
- Camera and film
- Pocket knife (tot'n chip)
- Binoculars
- Clothes line (clothes pins and flagging tape)
- Work gloves
- Envelopes, paper and stamps (don't forget to write home)
- Backpack (for backpacking merit badge)
- Bicycle and helmet (for cycling merit badge)
- Fishing Pole and tackle (license if 17 or older)
- Spending money

### DO NOT BRING

- Fireworks
- Firearms
- Valuables
- Alcohol or drugs
- Sheath knife
- Pets (Including parents night)
